When you complete the "Request for estimate "online form, all details you supply may be collected by the funeral home/s you have selected for the purpose of providing services and information to you.

Each funeral home is a privately owned business with its own privacy policy in respect of the information they collect from you. We recommend you read their policies so you can understand the manner in which your personal information will be handled by these providers.

Withdrawing Consent:

By providing personal information to an intended recipient, you imply consent for them to use your information to provide products or services to you.

If after your contact with either of these parties, you consequently change your mind and wish to withdraw consent, you should contact us by <u>email</u>.

We may disclose your personal information if we are required by law to do so.

Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to your computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes. Most web browsers are set to accept cookies.
